## Lots of Prevention!

12 prevention coalitions were supported in 8 counties

40 youth were matched with an adult mentor

81 Educational presentations or workshops were completed

172 Anger Management sessions were provided

108 Parent Education sessions were held

120 free counseling sessions with youth were provided

Other Support and referral were provided to 79 families

## Outcomes!

- ◆ Two coalitions implemented prevention projects through a \$5000 mini-grant funding award written and submitted by staff.
- ◆ 94% of TOP participants report no use of alcohol in the last 30 days. 97% report no use of marijuana in the last 30 days
- ◆ 83.3% of parents of youth in the mentoring program report their child's behavior has improved or remained positive after one year in the program. 50% of 1<sup>st</sup>-year youth participant report an increase in positive attitude.
- ◆ Several hundred pounds of prescription and over the counter medications were collected and safely disposed of in the service area.
  - ◆ TATU trained youth improved their knowledge of tobacco health and prevention by 25%.
  - ◆ 275 Tobacco retailers were visited and provided information to prevent tobacco sales to minors.
- ◆ RSC staff and prevention project coordinators from two coalitions presented separately at the annual prevention conference about their projects and outcomes.
