Mentoring Makes a Difference!

38 Youth were served through Mentoring
2085.5 Hours of Mentoring were provided

New Programs and Services

Mental Health First Aid Training was provided for 197 participants through 8 one-day training events

Provided tobacco retailer compliance survey checks in 32 Southeast Missouri Counties

Assisted in the development and implementation of the Phelps County System of Care Team

Lots of Prevention!

- ◇ Active attendance and participation in 69 coalition meetings in the 8 county service area
- ◇ Technical assistance provided 65 times outside of coalition meetings
- ◇ Assistance with securing over \$42,000 in funding for coalition prevention activities
- ◇ Conducted 29 education workshops and presentations with adults reaching 796 individuals
- ◇ Provided 69 education and interactive training events with 1643 youth
- ◇ Participated in 6 public awareness events reaching 2374 individuals
- ◇ Facilitated 71 Teen Outreach Program sessions in the after school program with 20+ youth
- ◇ Contact with an average of 1825 individuals each month through programs and services
- ◇ Visited 257 tobacco retailers in 8 counties to provide employee training materials and state law information to prevent sales to minors
- ◇ Conducted 110 tobacco retailer compliance survey checks in 32 counties

Total Expenses =
\$229,308.74

Some Highlighted Outcomes

- ◆ Two coalitions implemented prevention projects through \$5000 grant funding awards written with staff assistance
- ◆ 83% of parents of youth in mentoring report their child’s behavior has improved or remained positive after one year in the program
- ◆ 781 pounds of drugs were collected in year one of the permanent drug drop box placed at the local police department

Direct Services Provided

- ⇒ 62 Parent Education Class Sessions
- ⇒ 65 Anger Management Class Sessions
- ⇒ 85 hours of free counseling and referral
